

## GRAND STRAND BOWLERS ELECT SIX MEMBERS TO THE BOWLING HALL OF FAME

The Board of Directors of the Grand Strand Association of the United States Bowling Congress elected six bowlers for enshrinement in the Grand Strand Bowling Hall of Fame at its November meeting. The honorees are Marge Bosky, Veteran, Marilyn Dumas and Mike Hardee for Bowling Achievement, Karen Clevinger and Derrell Kicklighter for Meritorious Service and Larry Nowak, Honorary.

Marge Bosky of Myrtle Beach has bowled in the area for 27 years and was among the top ten women bowlers throughout the 1980's and early 1990's.

Marilyn Dumas of Myrtle Beach became one of the leading bowlers in 1994 and has continued in the top echelon for the past 15 years. Her resume includes a 300 game, a 742 series and a one year average of 201.

Mike Hardee of Loris has been Bowler of the Year twice, has 14 perfect games, 10 series over 800 and a one year high average of 233.

Karen Clevinger of Myrtle Beach has served as a Director of the bowling associations for nine years, has been a league secretary for several years and has been named Secretary of the Year.

Derrell Kicklighter of Conway began bowling in the area in 1990 and has been a board member for 10 years. He is also a Director on the South Carolina State Board of Directors.

Larry Nowak of Myrtle Beach is the Proprietor of the Waccamaw Bowling Center on Gray Drive just off US 501 at the waterway. Since moving to the Grand Strand in 1995, Larry has been very supportive of the bowlers and the bowling organizations in the area and his contributions have been significant.

The induction ceremony will be held on March 6, 2010, at the Holiday Inn West. All GSUSBCA bowlers and their friends are invited to attend.
